

## Tests and Diplomas

### DELTA-DALF

DELTA (Diplôme d'études en langue française) and DALF (Diplôme approfondi de langue française) are official qualifications awarded by the French Ministry of Education (Centre international d'études pédagogiques, CIEP) to certify French language competence of candidates from outside of France.

Four skills are evaluated for each of the six diplomas (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, and C2): listening, speaking, reading, and writing. **Alliance Française is the only test centre in Bangladesh for all DELTA-DALF examinations.**

### TCF AND TEF

**TCF (Test de connaissance du français):** Alliance Française de Dhaka is an examination centre for TCF Canada (Test de connaissance du français Canada). The TCF Canada is a French language proficiency test that meets the standards of Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). TCF Canada results are accepted for economic immigration or for obtaining Canadian citizenship.

**TEF (Test d'évaluation du français):** Alliance Française de Dhaka is an examination centre for TEF (Test d'évaluation de français). The TEF is an international benchmark test that measures your level of knowledge and skills in French.
